

Purchasing and downloading Apple iBooks & ESCO EdTech eBooks

What's the difference between and iBook and an eBook?

- An iBook is an electronic book designed specifically for an iPad and can only be accessed on an iPad.
- An eBook is an electronic book designed for any electronic reader including the iPad but does not have the unique features of iBooks.
- Not all books are available in an iBook format so are offered by ESCO/EdTech as an eBook.
- Some books are not offered in either format and so are available from ESCO as a printed book.
- The provided "2015-16 Book List" shows the format for each required book.

Where do I buy Apple iBooks?

• All iBooks should be purchased through ESCO.

How does the iBook purchase get on to the students' iPads?

- Download the app from the app store called "ShelfIt by ESCO". It is a free download.
- Login to the "ShelfIt" App using your ESCO credentials. It will pull up your bookshelf by subject.
- Click on the bookshelf of the book you want to access, and then click on the book image. It will then say "Save Book to iPad?" Click yes, and it will start downloading. Once the progression circle turns completely blue and then goes away, the book is done downloading.
- Click on the book image again and it open the iBook.

Is it possible to share iBooks between family members?

- We do not recommend it because there are various issues that can occur. If you consider yourself highly technical (and a little daring) you can possibly create a shared common Apple ID to purchase the books for all family members. However, it is best to buy unique redemption codes for each book for each of your students.
- Another route is through the current iPad software (new in iOS 8 last fall) which includes the ability to share iTunes, App Store, and iBook purchases through what Apple calls "Family Sharing" (Apple IDs that share the same credit card info), but this needs to be set up on your end and there is no guarantee that all books will be "shareable."
- Note: Some iBook purchases expire after one year, meaning that you pay for one year of access and if you'd like another year you must buy it again.

Where do I buy eBooks?

• All eBooks are purchased through ESCO.

How does the eBook purchase get on to the students' iPad?

- Download the app from the app store called "ShelfIt by ESCO". It is a free download.
