Dear Parents:

As we continue to enjoy the blessings of a northern Michigan summer, the school year draws near. With that in mind, I would like to take a moment to pass along some uniform and handbook reminders. Below you will find some brief highlights; please be sure to reference the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton handbook and Mr. Buell's June uniform letter for more detailed information.

- The largest change for the upcoming school year is that pants MUST be either Dennis or Land's End. It is important that either brand choice must fit modestly.
- Many of you have already placed and received your uniform orders. Be sure to get items out and try them. (Dennis Uniform logo'd items will begin shipping in early August). When returning for a refund or exchange, you may use the Dennis online return label for \$6.50 or you can choose your own method such as UPS or USPS. If you haven't ordered yet, now is a good time to start that process.
- Girls, when trying on your items please make sure that skirts and pants meet handbook policy, which is that skirts hit "at or below the knee" and pants are worn modestly.
- We ask that you purchase a "cold weather" top for your student to wear in the fall and winter months. With plenty of choices in the Dennis online store, we are confident there is something for every student. As a reminder, other items like sweatshirts and jackets are not allowed to be worn in school.
- Boys, we ask that you come to school with your hair cut in compliance with our handbook which states that hair must be neat and clean (out of the eyes and off the collar).
- Again, you will find greater detail in the handbook, in Mr. Buell's letter, and in our uniform FAQs, but also keep in mind that all previously approved polo shirts and previously allowed Land's End uniform chinos may be worn. Lands' End skirts may be worn for the next three years if worn modestly (at or below the knee).
- We ask that you send your students to school in modest clothing that is in line with our uniform policy. In turn, we will monitor and enforce the policies at school. With your help. Corrective action and discipline by the school should be the exception, not the norm.

Thank you for your attention and help surrounding the uniform and appearance standards. I pray that you enjoy the rest of your summer.
