Approximately \$100 Stacking firewood, building projects, trail maintenance, community support projects.

TRAVERSE CITY - January 3-5, 2019

Approximately \$125 Working with Safe Harbor, activities with patients at Cherry Hill Memory Care center, and serving at GladMeals.

ABBEVILLE, LOUISIANA - March 22-31, 2019

Approximately \$750-\$1,000 Various work projects in the local community, prayer ministry.

GRAND RAPIDS - April 4-6 2019

Approximately \$125 Working in God's Kitchen serving community meals, assisting with community activities, playing with African refugee children.

DETROIT - May 17-20, 2019

Approximately \$125 Working in Capuchin Food Kitchen serving community meals, Gleaners Food Bank.

LOCAL/FREEDOM BUILDERS - June 12-14, 2019

Approximately \$125 Building projects to serve underprivileged in the Grand Traverse area, serve at GladMeals, the community meal hosted by St. Francis High School each Saturday.

AVE MARIA / ST. TERESA PROJECT (FLORIDA) - June 17-21, 2019

Approximately \$600-\$750 Various work projects in the local community, serve in the Missionaries of Charity soup kitchen, prayer ministry. **Scholarships** are available for qualifying students

Dates and **costs** are tentative and based on prior experience of preliminary travel cost estimates
