NEW STUDENTS - APPLY

To enroll a *new* student (even if siblings already attend school here), begin by going to the Admissions page on our website. Current families should use their existing RenWeb log-in information. New families should create a new RenWeb account. Our school code is GTV-MI. **This process occurs year-round and should be done as soon as enrollment plans are known.**

If you're not certain of the grade level in which the student will ultimately enroll, please contact Admissions to advise you on how to apply and enroll that particular student. Examples include transfer students or questions regarding placement for preschoolers.

ALL STUDENTS - ENROLL

Reenrollment invitations will be emailed to current students' families via RenWeb on or about January 27 for preschool and February 24 for K-12.

For new students, after your application has been submitted, you will receive an email invitation to enroll via RenWeb based on the enrollment schedule.

While the enrollment process is the same for new or returning students, priority placement is given to returning students in the event of capacity constraints. Returned enrollment packets are time-stamped so be sure to return yours as soon as possible.
