- Use a rimmed baking sheet with coarse salt, sugar, flour, or shaving cream and your pointer/index finger to practice writing your Red Words.
- If your child read all of the words correctly, you can time him or her for fun. We only compete against ourselves...

□ <u>Read for 20 minutes today</u>.

Then have your child follow the rest of the directions...box welded **ng** and **nk** sounds, underline base words, and circle suffixes.

□ Fluency Practice (speed and accuracy) with the new Welded Sounds—Page 2-3 WRS Step-2-Passages, "The Fish Tank"

Spend some time reading this passage together with your child. It reinforces the phonics lesson this week so it contains many words with the ng and nk welded sounds. At a minimum, have your child work through the first paragraph. You also could take turns each of you reading one sentence.

□ **<u>Red Word work</u>**. Continue practicing the Red Words from List #1. Read the words. Note any mistakes.

- Read the words on Red Word list #1. Note any mistakes.
- Arm-Tap the words that were missed (3 times each).

- Use your dominant hand to "sky write" the word with your eyes closed! Try it with eyes open!
- Use your dominant to write the word with your finger on the table.
- If your child read all of the words correctly, you can time him or her again today. We only compete against ourselves...

□ <u>Read for 20 minutes today</u>.

FRIDAY

□ Say a Hail Mary.

□ Continue to practice reading "The Fish Tank" today and this weekend with your child.

□ Practice any Red Words that may have been tricky. Use them in a sentence.
