## HOW TO ACCESS BOOKS (EBOOKS, AUDIO, REAL BOOKS)

As ALWAYS please be sure that you do some research into the title you want to read. Is it appropriate? Ask your parents!!! What is the book level and the interest level? Find out on <a href="https://www.arbookfind.com">www.arbookfind.com</a>

- Amazon: Amazon offers a 30 day free trial for their Kindle Unlimited. You can download new magazines, books, and audiobooks. After 30 days your subscription will renew automatically unless you cancel before the free trial expires. It is easy to cancel a subscription. I also found some links online (do a quick google search) for a free two month trial. You do NOT need a kindle for these Kindle eBooks. You can download the Kindle app from your app store. Not every book is free with Kindle Unlimited. Just the ones labeled as such.
- Audible app: you can download a free 30 day membership and listen to one audiobook.
- Downtown Book Stores: Another great resource is our downtown book stores:
