As we begin the final week of our 2019-20 academic year, I wanted to share a few details regarding the end of the year. On Wednesday, June 3 and Thursday, June 4, the building will be open from 9 am-4 pm for students to drop off textbook/school-owned items and to clean out personal items from their lockers.
