This week you will continue to analyze poems from your *Poetry Anthology*. Use the guidelines below about how to read a poem. Then answer the questions provided in the packet. Use the green resource pages to define any difficult poetry vocabulary.

How to read poetry

- Read the **title** of the poem. What might the poem be about?
- Read the poem aloud **3** times.
- Define difficult **vocabulary**.
- Visualize the **images**. Paint a picture in your head.
- What is the poem mostly about? (**Main Idea**=One-sentence summary)
- What is the **mood** (feeling) of the poem?
- What **theme** (message) is the author giving the reader?
