□ <u>Comprehension Work including Closed Syllable Words with Blends</u> . – Page 18 WRS Workbook.  Read the directions. Have your child read the word choices in the box. Read the sentences. Once the correct word is filled in, have your child reread the completed sentence.

□ <u>Say a Hail Mary</u> .
□ <u>DAILY Sound Review</u> – vowels, consonants, digraphs, and the welded sounds. Have your child watch this and practice along with the video.

□ <u>FLUENCY Practice</u> —Page 25 WRS Student Reader (again).  Practice reading the words on the word list just like you did on Tuesday. You can do just the top half again with your child, or move on if he or she seems ready.
□ More Fluency Practice with Closed Syllables — Page 32 fluency sentences.  Have your child read each sentence correctly two times. Depending on your child's stamina, you may choose just 5 sentences. If he or she gets stuck on a word, go back to the beginning of that sentence. This may seem tedious, but it is effective. Have your child read each sentence correctly TWICE. See if your child can identify the closed syllable words in the first 3 sentences.
□ <b>Red Word work</b> . Continue practicing the Red Words from List # 1. Read the words. Note any mistakes.
- Use the arm-tapping technique.

- Use your dominant hand to "sky write" the words.
- Use your dominant to write the word with your finger on the table.
- If your child can read them all correctly, trying timing him or her.

□ Read for 20 minutes today.
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#### **FRIDAY**
