□ <u>Comprehension Work including Multisyllabic Words</u> – Page 12 WRS Workbook Select syllables from the top of each box to make REAL words. Read the words you made in each box.
□ Comprehension Work including Multisyllabic Words – Page 17 WRS Workbook  Read the directions. Have your child read the word choices in the box. Read the sentences. Once the correct word is filled in, have your child reread the completed sentence. Use each word just once.
