On our academic year calendar, we had designated several periods as possible days off for health and safety reasons. The decision has now been made that there will be no school on November 23 and 24. This also means that there will not be St. Joseph Club available for Immaculate Conception students on those two days. An updated academic year calendar is attached. Two days designated in a similar way for December are still pending and will be decided on later in November.
