CASE NOTICE

On Sunday, we learned that an adult member of the St. Francis High School community has tested positive for COVID-19. If there are any close contacts as a result of this exposure, those individuals will be notified by phone or email. The impact to our school community is expected to be minimal. If you/your student is not a close contact, you will not hear from anyone.

We are moving forward under the guidance of the Health Department and taking any measures necessary to protect the well-being of our students and staff. As always, please monitor for symptoms related to COVID-19 including fever, cough, difficulty breathing, headache, or new fatigue.

The Grand Traverse County Health Department is seeing an increase in cases and asks for your patience and understanding while awaiting contact tracing notifications. Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 should self-isolate and notify close contacts of their need to quarantine for 14 days from the date of their last contact with the infected person.
